

ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Intent & Purpose

Springmount Services is committed to sustainably conducting its business with a minimum negative impact on the environment. We are committed to the prevention of pollution, waste minimisation and carbon footprint reduction and will always have in place waste containment and waste/carbon minimisation systems.

Principles

The company will continually improve its environmental performance through systematic monitoring and measurement of its environmental sustainability program against ISO14001 and customers' needs.

Operation and Incidence

Commitment and Communication

We are committed to:

- Compliance, at a minimum, with local, State and Federal environmental legislators and regulators and other supporting guidelines and codes of practice as necessary to meet its own stated objectives, contractual obligations and those of regulatory bodies
- Setting annually and periodically reviewing environmental objectives and targets
- Putting in place waste and energy minimisation processes with proper waste handling and containment strategies as a critical objective for operations
- Planning the purchasing of new plant, equipment and hazardous substances with consideration for environmental performance capabilities
- Maintaining an environmental reporting system to allow management to be informed of critical environmental developments, particularly environmental incidents
- Considering community concerns on environmental issues.

Objectives and Targets

Our targets will be recalibrated at regular intervals as determined by our IMS. However, the following principles will apply:

- Minimise water usage in the workplace, wherever possible, by cutting water consumption
- Minimise electrical power usage in the workplace by turning off lights when night cleaning is not being undertaken, whenever possible
- Re-use cleaning cloths by collecting cloths previously used in food service areas and re-using them on industrial sites for other less critical cleaning processes.
- Collect paper, cardboard, plastic and glass waste for recycling purposes.
- Purchase chemicals that are biodegradable and/or low toxicity and encourage our suppliers to provide chemicals only in reusable containers.
- Maximise diversion from landfill.
